You will be equipped with foundational Biblical principles and principles of development, that will allow you to know how to set up and run a CHE programme, in its many and varied models.

CHE/TOT1 is for anyone preparing for cross-cultural mission, short or long-term, particularly amongst the poor, who wants to develop a Biblical framework for doing community health and development or wholistic ministry. Non-medical people as well as healthcare professionals.
